ANNUAL AWARDS OF SPFCA – 2022: (FOR SPFCA LIFE MEMBERS ONLY)

The SPFCA confers a number of awards every year to encourage personnel, who have excelled in professional competence and contributed to the advancement of knowledge in farm and companion animal welfare. The last date for receiving application for award is 15th October 2022. The awards are listed below:

1. Dr. C.M. Singh Best Researcher Award: This award will be granted to the researcher having the best research paper (Published during June 2021- May 2022) as a first author. The awardee will receive a medal and certificate whereas the coauthors will receive a certificate only.

2. SPFCA Fellow Award: This award will be granted to the faculty having outstanding contribution in the field of teaching, research and extension with a minimum experience of 15 years. The awardee will receive a memento, certificate and citation.

3. Dr. Rameshwar Singh Best Oration Award: The award will be given to young research professional of age less than 36 years. The awardee will receive a memento, certificate and prize money of Rs 5000/- only.

Travel
