About the National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (India) NAVS (I)

The National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (India) is an apex premier agency for the development of Veterinary Sciences in India. It was established on lines similar to the National Academy of Medical Sciences by eminent visionary Veterinarian to promote and consolidate the scientific views on livestock sector in National economy through promotion of animal welfare. It has been registered by the Registrar of Societies, Delhi vide Registration Certificate No. S/24471 of 1993 dated 7th July, 1993 and has emerged as the largest think-tank of all branches of the profession for research & development departments of the country engaged in Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Sectors. The Academy was established to promote the interests of Veterinarians in the country and was launched with Dr. Chinta Mani Singh, a doyen of Veterinary Services in India, as its Founder President. The academy was formally inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister of State for Animal Husbandry and Dairying (Independent Charge) Government of India Dr. Raghuvansh Prasad Singh on 18th December, 1996 in Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi and the Scrolls of Fellowship to the duly elected National Fellows/Members during 1994-95 were presented to them by the Hon'ble Minister at the Investiture ceremony.

NAVS (I) was established with the aim and objective of promoting knowledge of Veterinary Sciences, its practical application, and to secure coordination between veterinarians and other scientific academic societies, associations,

institutions and veterinary/animal husbandry scientific developments and services. The Academy has about 450 members, including Fellows, Institutional and Corporate Members and Elected Members. The association is successfully organizing its annual conferences/symposia and Convocations for awarding fellowships recognizing the lifetime achievement of its members. Bihar Animal Sciences University, headquartered in Patna, was established under the Bihar Animal Sciences University Act No. 15 of 2016, notified in the Bihar Gazette on August 29, 2016, and became operational on June 13, 2017, with the appointment of its first Vice Chancellor. Carved out from the Bihar Agricultural University, BASU inherited two key constituent colleges: Bihar Veterinary College and Sanjay Gandhi Institute of Dairy Technology, while establishing two new colleges, namely the College of Fisheries and the College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences at Kishanganj. To bolster its research and outreach, the university also absorbed several specialized institutes and research stations. BASU excels in delivering specialized education across Veterinary Sciences, Animal Husbandry, Poultry, Fisheries, Dairy and allied disciplines, while advancing cutting-edge research and extension programs to empower rural Bihar's communities. 
