

Call For Abstract

The Organizing Committee warmly invites all participating scientists to submit abstracts of their research papers via email osspfca2025@gmail.com on or before 31 December 2025. To ensure eligibility, at least one of the authors must register for the conference at the time of abstract submission. The accepted abstracts will be compiled and published in the Abstract/Souvenir Book, Authors are requested to adhere to the following guidelines while preparing their submissions:

- 1.Formatting: Use Garamond font, size 12, with double spacing. The document should be submitted in a Word file format (.doc or .docx).
- 2. Word Count: Abstracts should not exceed 300 words.
- 3.Title and Authors: Include the title of the research, followed by the names of all authors in italics.
- 4. Presenter Information: Clearly indicate the presenting author by marking their name with an asterisk (*) and provide their email address and phone number.
- 5. Affiliation: Include the institutional affiliation of the authors.
- 6.Keywords: Add 4–5 relevant keywords at the end of the abstract to reflect the research content.
- 7.Conference Theme: Specify the thematic area under which the abstract is being submitted.

These guidelines will help streamline the submission process and ensure consistency in the published Abstract/Souvenir Book.

Annual Awards for SPFCA-2024 (for Life Members Only)

SPFCA confers a number of awards every year to encourage Veterinarians, who have excelled in professional competence and contributed to the advancement of knowledge in Farm and Companion animal welfare. The last date for receiving application for award is 20 October 2025. The awards are listed below:

- **1. SPFCA Fellow Award:** This award will be granted to the faculty having outstanding contribution in the field of teaching, research and extension with a minimum experience of 15 years. The awardee will receive a memento, certificate and citation
- 2. Dr. C.M. Singh Best Research Article Award: This award will be granted to the first author of the best research article published during June 2023 to May 2024 and June 2024 to May 2025. The awardee will receive a medal and certificate whereas the co-authors will receive a certificate only.
- **3. Dr. Rameshwar Singh Best Oration Award:** The award will be given to young research professional of age less than 36 years. The awardee will receive a memento, certificate and prize money of Rs 5000/-only.
